Chris's Place Child Advocacy Center provides a child-friendly environment and developmentally-appropriate forensic interview for victims of sexual abuse and severe physical abuse.

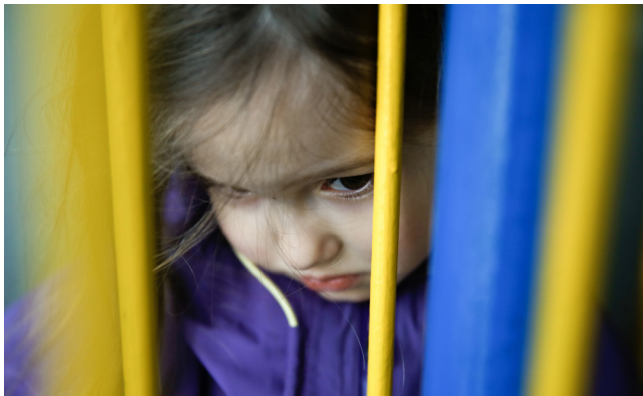
**Reducing trauma** to victims by limiting the number of interviews they must undergo,
